



Embedding Risk Management: Training Workshops

What is it?

This practical IRM accredited course is the next step for Risk Practitioners who know or have read about the process of risk management; you understand what it's all about, but you need to understand and overcome the barriers to getting risk management into the life blood of the organisation. In interactive workshop sessions we explore those barriers and analyse the solutions using advanced risk management and general management tools and techniques.

How do you approach the training?

We deliver the training during a two day interactive course using the full range of pedagogical skills so you learn through listening, seeing and doing.

Much of what we cover in the course deserves a great deal longer than we can cater for on a short course such as this. So we present each subject like a tool to put in your own toolkit. You can then learn the techniques and skills in your own time after the course using the models, tools, links and further learning lists that we provide. Oh, sorry, there is some homework to do beforehand as well.

We demonstrate through games, exercises and story telling how each application or tool can be implemented, and we weave the whole together so each part leads to the next as part of a natural progression.

Why should I attend the course?

You learn general management skills in a risk management context, such as

- Risk in the context of it being a threat and / or an opportunity
- How to harness other internal activities to get the most out of risk management
- Tools for making risk management appealing to all of your audiences
- Monitoring and reporting risk management in a value added way
- Audit - its role, and how to maximise it
- Working out risk tolerance and risk appetite – practical ways of doing it
- Ownership of risk and of risk controls
- Using value to calculate the “cost” of a risk and work out the costs / benefits of controls
- Persuasion, negotiation, influencing, delegating
- Advanced selling techniques and leadership tools



What is the output from the course?

You come away with an action plan of how you are going to re-open those doors that have been closed to you, and how you are going to use your new tools and techniques to get greatest buy-in from the people you most want to influence. Previous delegates report that this course gave them new energy and confidence in taking risk management to the next stage in their organisations. All the course materials and work completed are provided on a CD Rom, we send you the material we worked on after the course and you get a certificate and CPD points.

What is the timing for the course?

So you get two whole days' work with only one night away from home, day 1 starts at 10:15 and goes on until 17:00 pm. Day 2 starts at 09:00 and finishes at 16:00pm.
